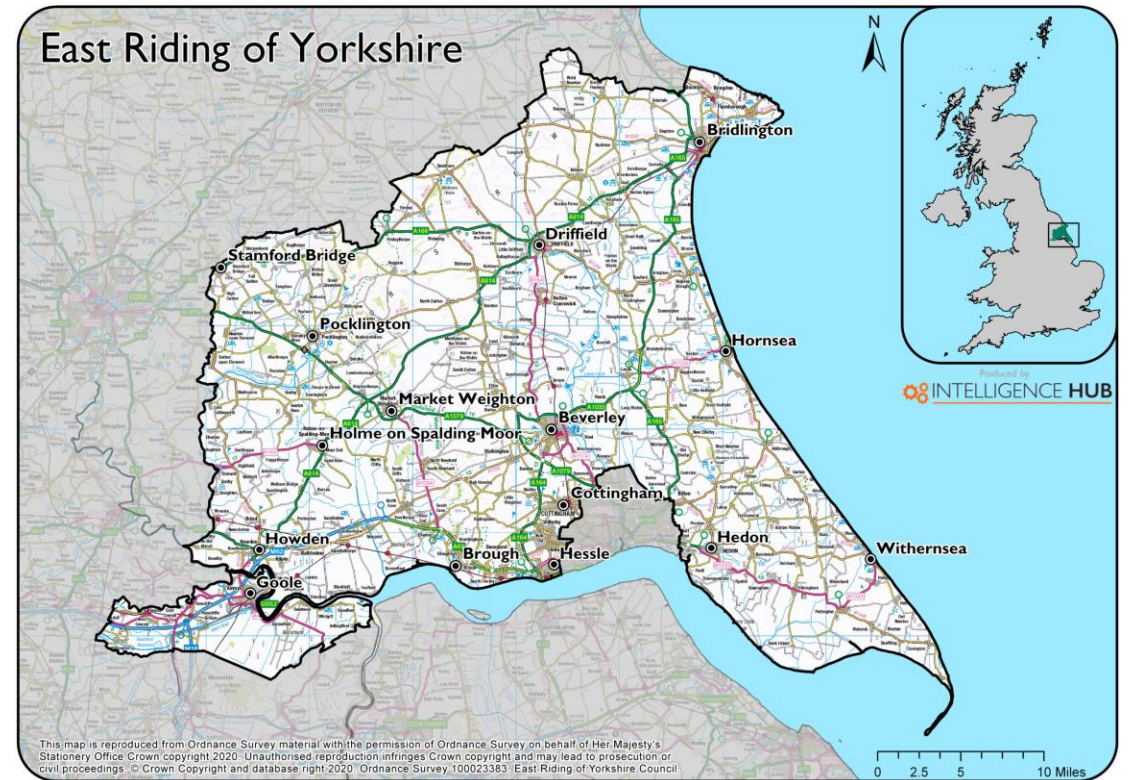




Adult Social Care - Care Home Situation

Report

October 2025



Overview

- The total number of people living in residential care in-county contracted through ERYC is currently 2,161.
- 1,448 people have a primary support reason of Support with Memory and Cognition, 395 of Physical Support, 226 of Learning Disability and 99 of Mental Health. We have 52 Nursing residents & 2,109 residential residents.
- The average length of a placement is 753 days.
- There are currently 137 registered care homes in the East Riding of Yorkshire.

This data is calculated through a combination of Azeus service provisions and vacancies listed on Capacity Tracker. Data regarding people paying privately for their care is unknown and is calculated through deducting ERYC placements and vacancies listed. Fees vary across homes and areas and are not always aligned with ERYC rates which may impact the number of vacancies.

Of the 17 Out of County placements made, 15 were in Hull or other neighbouring authorities.

Summary

- Our occupancy level varies between 82.8% and 91.7% depending on CWT area.
- Our highest occupancy is in Holderness at 91.7%, with 26 placements being made in October.
- Our highest vacancies are in Bridlington (157) with 31 placements made in October.
- The lowest occupancy rate is in Bridlington (82.8%).
